Next Meeting of Peninsula Orchid Society is March 27, 2015 at the Garden Center, 605 Parkside Way, San Mateo, CA 94403. Doors open at 7:00 p.m. **Skill Session at 7:00 meeting at 7:30.**

OUR FEATURED SPEAKER for the March meeting is Carol Klonowski. Carol has been growing orchids since the 1980s when a Berkeley friend gave her a Cattleya. The plant bloomed with three big dark-lavender very fragrant flowers. Carol built a greenhouse to accommodate the precious plant, and, consequently needed more orchids so that this plant would not be lonely. So, she purchased more. Another friend gifted her with a membership in the Orchid Society of California in Oakland, and it has been a passion ever since.

Carol can recall attending monthly meetings at OSC and Diablo View Orchid Society when orchid legends such as the late Frank Fordyce and the late Dick Emory would be available to answer the many questions an eager hobbyist would have.

Carol has served as Director, Vice President, and President of OSC for most of the past two decades. She is also an Accredited Judge with the AOS California Sierra Nevada Judging Center and has served several years as their webmaster. We have seen Carol at many Peninsula Orchid Society meetings.

This talk covers the recent 21st World Orchid Conference (WOC) in Johannesburg, South Africa, and presents an overview of that most unique country's orchids. From the well-known Disas to rarer but no less interesting Bartholinas, and from fynbo, montane and savannah habitats, we will explore why South Africa was chosen as the host nation for this prestigious event. Also, Carol will offer a preview of the next WOC in Guayaquil, Ecuador, and detail reasons why everyone should want to attend.

SKILL SESSION- Ken Jacobsen. Ken will demonstrate the correct way to use virus test kits from Agdia to test for cymbidium-mosiac virus and Odontoglossum ring-spot virus. Some infected plants will demonstrate that they have the virus, but some will not. It is a good idea to check your collection from time-to-time to make sure you don't have any hidden carriers waiting to infect your other orchids. Ken will talk about the best method to test a large number of plants, for the least money. There may be some test supplies

available at the meeting for \$6 per test, or you may bring your freshly cut leaf samples to have a test done for \$6 per test at the skill session.

Barry Zimmerman would like to caution us that you could melt the tiny tips of these clippers in a very hot torch flame (near the tip of the inner cone of the flame), for some areas of the flame are hotter than the melting point of the stainless steel alloy used to make these little gems, so you'd rapidly lose the utility of these clippers. I add that the stainless grade used to fabricate these is not temperable, so you need not quench them (I do to quickly cool them.), and as long as you don't overheat them past a dull red glow, they'll not be degraded.
