## Orchid Conservation Alliance Newsletter

Dear OCA Friends,

The News on several fronts:

<u>Dracula Reserve Fundraising:</u> To my pleased amazement, between your donations and Orchids in the Wild trips, the Dracula Reserve fund stands at \$81,342 today. I am optimistic that we will actually reach our goal of \$110,000 by the end of the year. A few months ago I could hardly imagine it. In years past we have never raised more than \$46,000 for a reserve project. So I hope that those of you who have not donated yet this year will step up to the best of your ability and help out. Our funds will purchase 275 acres of Ecuadoran forest harboring the world's best collection of Dracula orchids. And I hope that those of you who have already donated can be counted on to make another donation before the end of the year. <u>Remember, all of these donations will be doubled by the Rainforest Trust and are fully tax deductible</u>. Donations can be sent to the OCA at the address below or made through our website's Donate button at <a href="https://orchidconservationalliance.org/">https://orchidconservationalliance.org/</a>.

Orchids in the Wild trips for 2018: In 2018 we will have trips to Chiapas, Mexico, in April, to Northwest Yunnan, China, in May-June, and to Colombia in November. The Chiapas itinerary is now posted on our website; in includes 15 days of orchids, pyramids, and amazing scenery. It's price will be posted ASAP. The Yunnan trip targets Chinese cyprepediums and the Colombian trip will focus

on the spectacular orchids of the northern Andes, several nurseries, and a visit to a new OCA sponsored reserve. Details will be published on our website as soon as they are available. Reservations are being accepted now; a \$500 deposit, payable to OCA and sent to our address below, holds your space on any of these trips. Note that the Chiapas trip is strictly limited to 14 travelers due to lodging restrictions at one of the isolated reserves we will visit.

## In an editorial, The New York Times noted that:

There is alarming new evidence that insect populations worldwide are in rapid decline. As Prof. Dave Goulson of the University of Sussex, a co-author of a new insect study, put it, we are "on course for ecological Armageddon" because "if we lose the insects, then everything is going to collapse" (NYT, Oct. 29, 2017)

In 2013 the OCA donated \$30,000, which was doubled by the Rainforest Trust, to expand Reserva Serra Bonita in Brazil's Atlantic Rainforest. This reserve in Brazil's Atlantic Rainforest, see <a href="http://orchidconservationalliance.org/projects/project-serra-bonita/">http://orchidconservationalliance.org/projects/project-serra-bonita/</a> was created by Vitor Becker and Clemira Souza with the specific goal of protecting Brazilian insect populations. From his life's work as a Brazilian entomologist, Becker was well aware of the decline in insect populations. The OCA visited, saw the project and the orchids that would also be protected by the reserve, and decided to help with expansion of the reserve. Wherever there are good orchid populations there are also good insect populations; both are indicators of a healthy ecology.

Next year I will be making an effort to write more frequent newsletters. Sometimes these will include orchid biology, sometimes conservation news, and sometimes videos of our trips. It would be great if you would let me know what you would like to hear or see! I'm taking two courses, video production and video editing.
