His collection includes lots of Cattleyas and Laelias, Cymbidiums, Oncidiums, Odontoglossums, Lycastes, Masdevallias, and other genera. Ken and his wife, Amy, enjoy travelling to all areas of the world where orchids are grown, visiting the local growers, and seeing various species in the wild. Together, Amy and Ken have over 5000 orchids, not counting seedlings (and there are a lot of seedlings!).

Ken is a judge in the AOS judging program, was a judge in the CSA judging program, and is a past AOS trustee.

In this talk, Ken will introduce the concept of choosing plants to grow into large specimens, growing them, and their care and maintenance once they become large. He will also provide our opportunity table plants for this month's meeting.
